**ARTICLE 2. General Acceptance of Reports**

Shall the reports of school district agents, auditors, committees, or officers chosen be accepted and placed on file?

**ARTICLE 3. Operating Budget**

Shall the Sanborn Regional School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote at the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling \$26,162,232? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be \$25,297,316 which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Sanborn Regional School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. (This warrant article does not include appropriations in any other warrant article.)

**ARTICLE 4. Special Education Expendable Trust Fund**

Shall the Sanborn Regional School District raise and appropriate up to One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) to be placed in the Special Education Fund, previously established, with such amount to be funded from the June 30, 2006 unreserved fund balance available for transfer on July 1, 2006. **(Recommended by the School Board) (Recommended by the Budget Committee)**

*(The funds for this article come from the 2005-2006 school budget surplus, if any, not from increased taxes.)*

#### **ARTICLE 5. Facilities Maintenance Expendable Trust Fund**

Shall the Sanborn Regional School District vote to raise and appropriate up to Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) to be placed in the Facilities Maintenance Expendable Trust Fund, previously established, for the purpose of paying unanticipated expenses for the maintenance of the district's facilities, with such amount to be funded from the June 30, 2006 unreserved fund balance available for transfer on July 1, 2006. **(Recommended by the School Board) (Recommended by the Budget Committee)**

*(The funds for this article come from the 2005-2006 school budget surplus, if any, not from increased taxes.)*

#### **ARTICLE 6. Drugs are Dangerous, Inc Funding**

(or DAD), a non-profit organization serving the Sanborn Regional School District in continuing and expanding parenting education programs. **(Recommended by the School Board) (Recommended by the Budget Committee)**

#### **ARTICLE 7. Football Funding**

These funds would be used to purchase equipment, cover athletic fees, provide coaching funds, and other ancillary expenses associated with the establishment of a junior varsity team. **(Recommended by the School Board) (Recommended by the Budget Committee)**

*(This article provides funding for a junior varsity football program with an additional \$10,000 of funding to come from the Touchdown Club.)*
